- Windows SharePoint Services has been renamed to SharePoint Foundation 2010.
- The product is not Microsoft Office SharePoint Server anymore, it's SharePoint Server.
- No more gradual upgrades.
- Significant emphasis on social computing.
- SharePoint supports large lists.
- Developers are welcome!


One Example: Facebook
